#### VANDERBILT UROLOGY SOCIETY VISITING PROFESSORSHIP AND RHAMY-SHELLEY LECTURE HISTORY

In 1972, when Mr. Richard Turner-Warwick was invited to visit the Vanderbilt Department of Urology as a guest speaker professor, an invitation was extended to the local community and in all former Vanderbilt Urology residents. The concept of combining a resident alumni reunion with an educational endeavor was enthusiastically received.

Three years later, in 1975, the Vanderbilt Urology Society was formed, consisting of all former Vanderbilt Urology residents in addition to present and former faculty. Major support for this leadership continues to come from the resident alumni group.

The Rhamy-Shelley Lecture honors two individuals who were instrumental in the development of the Urology Program at Vanderbilt. Dr. Robert K. Rhamy, a Professor and Chairman of the department from 1964 to 1981; he is remembered as a teacher and friend to his many former residents and faculty. Dr. Rhamy passed away in 2006.

Dr. Harry S. Shelley came to the Vanderbilt program in 1946, and for the next 25 years was Chief of the Urology Service at the Nashville Veterans Administration Hospital. He also distinguished himself as a beloved teacher of both residents and medical students.

## Stephen A. Boorjian, MD, FACS

Dr. Stephen A. Boorjian is the Carl Rosen Professor of Urology and the David and Anne Luther Chair of the Department of Urology at Mayo Clinic. He also serves as the Program Director for Mayo's Urologic Oncology Fellowship. He received his MD from Harvard Medical School, and was a resident in Urology at New York Presbyterian Hospital-Weill Cornell Medical Center. He subsequently completed a fellowship in Urologic Oncology at Mayo Clinic. Dr. Boorjian has co-authored over 500 manuscripts and book chapters, and was recognized as "Teacher of the Year" in Urology for 2012 by the Mayo Clinic Fellows' Association. He received the Young Urologist of the Year award from the AUA in 2014 and 2018, as well as the 2016 Young Investigator Award from the Society of Urologic Oncology. He was a previous member of the NCCN Guidelines Panels for Bladder Cancer and Penile Cancer, has served as a member of the AUA Non-Muscle Invasive Bladder Cancer Guideline Panel, as co-chair of the AUA Microhematuria Guideline Panel, and as Vice Chair of the Clinically Localized Prostate Cancer Guideline Panel. He is a former Associate Editor of European Urology. Clinically, his practice includes a breadth of urologic oncology, including bladder cancer, kidney cancer (in particular, locally advanced tumors with tumor thrombus), prostate cancer, testicular cancer, and penile cancer.

## Christopher Anderson, MD

Dr. Christopher B. Anderson, MD MPH is the Given Foundation Associate Professor of Urology and Director of Urologic Oncology at Columbia University Irving Medical Center. He completed his medical degree at Northwestern University followed by a urology residency at Vanderbilt University Medical Center. He then completed a urologic oncology fellowship at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center and obtained a Master of Public Health from Harvard University. Dr. Anderson is a urologic oncologist with an expertise in prostate, bladder, kidney, testis, and penile cancer. He is also the residency Program Director for the Columbia Urology, Assistant Editor for the Journal of Urology, and an active researcher.
